EDUCATION

ATTORNEYS - Approval for Minimum Continuing Legal Education credit by the State Bar of Texas Committee on MCLE, the State Bar College, the Texas Center for the Judiciary and the Texas Board of Legal Specialization in an amount up to 15 credit hours, of which up to 3 hours will apply to legal ethics/professional responsibility credit, is currently pending. The course is also meant to meet the requirements of the Texas Estates Code Section 1054.201 and the Texas Government Code Section 81.114, which provides for attorney instruction on guardianship issues and certification for attorneys who wish to represent an applicant in a quardianship proceeding or who wish to be appointed as a court-appointed attorney in guardianship proceedings. Guardianship certification is currently pending.

CPAs - San Antonio Estate Planners Council is registered with the Texas State Board of Public Accountancy to offer courses. It is anticipated that the course will be approved for up to 12 hours of continuing professional education credit.

TRUST OFFICERS - Approval by the Institute of Certified Bankers for continuing education credits for CTFAs is currently pending. It is anticipated that the course will be approved for up to 12 hours of credit.

CFP, CLU, ChFC - Approval is pending for these certifications/designations.
